Syllabus Overview

Course Outline

In each session, half of the day will be dedicated to theory and principles, and the other half will involve the application of learned material to clinical cases. Radar Homeopathy software will be used in clinical application to help students become rapidly comfortable with the program. This course is taught using spiral learning application, in which students will learn by seeing the same concept applied in multiple different approaches.

Sessions One and Two:

The goals of sessions one and two are to introduce the foundations of homeopathic healing and its application to veterinary medicine for acute prescribing. We will also introduce the concepts of chronic disease, and how to differentiate between acute illness and acute flare ups of chronic disease.

- Keynote Prescribing for Acute Conditions, including
 - Gastrointestinal complaints
 - Respiratory
 - Acute injuries and trauma
 - Lameness



- Principles of Case Intake – acute and chronic disease
- Training and application of Radar Homeopathic Software for cases
- Business Models for Homeopathy

Sessions Three, Four, Five:

The goals of these sessions are to teach chronic disease from the perspective of homeopathic healing and cure, which occurs at the level of the vital force using the totality of symptoms. The faculty will combine the theory and principles of classical homeopathy with the clinical applications of veterinary medicine. Session 5 will consist almost exclusively of clinical practice application of chronic disease.

Objectives and Topics in Chronic Disease Sessions

- Understand the difference between palliation, suppression, and cure
- Recognize the patient's totality of symptoms
- Learn to recognize the patterns of disease in relation to chronic miasms
- Know the major anti-miasmatic remedies and be able to recognize them in patients
- Develop case-receiving strategies for intake consultations for initiating treatment of chronic disease
- Develop skill in managing chronic cases, including evaluation of patient response and second prescription
- Understand the importance of posology in remedy selection for each patient
- Use of LM/Q potencies
- Demonstrate the theory of homeopathic healing in clinical situations, using cases from faculty instructor's practice and cases from students
- Understanding application of homeopathic healing for chronic conditions including but not limited to:
 - Cancer
 - Dermatitis, otitis, allergies
 - Digestive disorders
 - Cardiopulmonary conditions
 - Seizures and neurologic conditions
 - Immune mediated diseases and disorders
 - Hospice care
